Preparing for Your Cruise

Now is the time to finalize your plans for *The 80s Cruise!*

Pop those collars, unleash the shoulder pads, tease that hair and slip into your hottest acid-washed jeans because *The 80s Cruise 2025* is about to set sail!

Get ready for non-stop 80s excitement! From incredible concerts, mega-parties every night, and special meet and greets to Q&As with your favorite artists, interactive trivia sessions, 80s karaoke, and friendly competitions – every moment is a blast. It's a week-long party that never slows down, designed especially for those who are still an 80s kid at heart.

Please carefully review this information in its entirety, even if you have previously sailed with Entertainment Cruise Productions, as some processes and procedures may have changed.

CHECK OUT MY ROYAL CRUISE

My Royal Cruise is Royal Caribbean's Pre-Cruise Planner, the place to plan your cruise while getting the most out of your travel adventure. Securing reservations and purchasing cruise package deals before you sail lets you score the best savings. From shore excursions to specialty dining to internet and spa services, check out all Royal Caribbean has to offer so you can save big NOW. LOCATE YOUR PASSPORT

Once located, check the expiration date. Your passport should have an expiration date of September 9, 2025, OR LATER (6 months AFTER the cruise sails). We highly recommend that all guests travel with a passport, but if you are a US Citizen and do not possess a passport, you may travel with an original birth certificate and valid state ID.

IMPORTANT! The original birth certificate must include a raised seal and the name on the state ID must match the birth certificate. Non-US Citizens should verify the required documentation by visiting the Booked Guests Portal on [The80sCruise.com](https://www.the80scruise.com).



PURCHASE TRAVEL INSURANCE

Picture this: You're all set for *The 80s Cruise*, bags packed, and your excitement level is at an all-time high. But then, out of nowhere, life throws you a curveball, just like when Cameron's dad's Ferrari took an unexpected dive off the ledge. Nobody saw that coming – and that's exactly why you need travel insurance. Whether it's a sudden illness, unexpected work emergency, or a Cameron-level crisis, having travel insurance ensures you're covered.

All payments made for a Reservation are non-refundable at the time of payment. Though insurance may be purchased up to 48 hours prior to sailing, to secure the broadest coverage, including pre-existing conditions, Travel Insurance should be purchased as early as possible. GETTING TO MIAMI, FLORIDA

Unless you reside near Miami, Florida, we recommend guests arrive in the area at least one day prior to embarkation day.

Once you arrive in Miami, Florida, you will be responsible for arranging transportation to the Port of Miami. Uber, Lyft, and taxi services are readily available and offer affordable transportation from nearby airports and/or hotels.

Boarding on March 2, 2025, typically begins around 11:00 AM ET, and all guests must be onboard no later than 3:00 PM ET.

45 Days prior to the cruise (January 16, 2025), you will receive email instructions on how to complete the required Online Check-In. At that time, you will select a Terminal Arrival Time. **DO NOT ARRIVE TO THE TERMINAL BEFORE YOUR SELECTED ARRIVAL TIME.**

GETTING HOME

Once the ship arrives back to Miami on March 9, 2025, Customs and Border Patrol will perform an inspection. After the ship has been cleared, you will be allowed to disembark.

Due to the time it takes to clear the ship, we recommend booking return flights after 12:00 PM on disembarkation day.

Uber, Lyft, and taxi services are readily available and offer affordable transportation to nearby airports.



Onboard Experience

On *The 80s Cruise*, you won't just see your favorite 80s musicians and icons perform on stage, you will also interact with them! Think star-studded game shows, Big 80s Trivia, Boozy Breakfast Bingo, 80s video games, and Cobra Kai Karaoke. Every 80s-infused event will make you laugh, smile, sing, and dance your way back in time to the **BEST. DECADE. EVER.**

Once inside your cabin, you'll find your Royal Caribbean SeaPass Card. It is important to keep this SeaPass Card with you throughout the week.

Royal Caribbean's SeaPass Card is a multifunctional card that serves many purposes including your cabin key, charge card for onboard purchases, entry into each night's Show in the Main Theater, and boarding pass for identification checking in and out of port.



NIGHTLY MAIN SHOWS

Each night, the Main Theater takes the spotlight where you can catch some of the incredible shows! Due to theater capacity, some shows are split into two viewings, based on SeaPass Card Color. Having two show times each night allows all guests the opportunity to see every performer. Guests with **BLUE SeaPass Cards** will attend the 1st Main Show (starting around 6:30 PM) and guests with **RED SeaPass Cards** will attend the 2nd Main Show (starting around 9:00 PM). Guests are required to adhere to their Main Show Time and will NOT be allowed into other shows. SeaPass Cards will be checked prior to entering the Main Theater. All other shows and venues are first come, first served unless indicated.



DINING OPTIONS

Onboard *The 80s Cruise*, dining options are as diverse as the decade's soundtrack. Whether you are looking for a quick bite, or a romantic dinner for two, the Explorer of the Seas has something for everyone, at any time! While dining reservations are not required, it is recommended you dine "opposite" of your Main Show time. Therefore, guests who attend the 1st Main Show are encouraged to dine after the show, while guests who attend the 2nd Main Show are encouraged to dine before the show.

Theme Nights

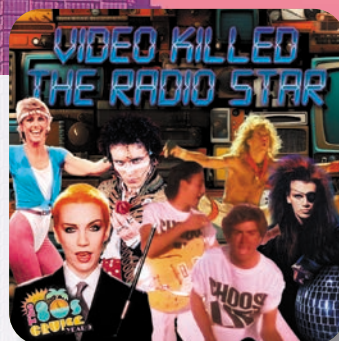

What to Expect Next

ONLINE CHECK IN & LUGGAGE TAGS

45 Days prior to the cruise you will receive instructions on how to complete Royal Caribbean's Online Check-In. Once your online check-in is complete, you can print your Set Sail Pass, which acts as your boarding pass for Embarkation Day. Guests who do not complete their online check-in will incur a substantial delay at the terminal on Embarkation Day.

30 Days prior to the cruise you will receive instructions on how to print your Royal Caribbean Luggage Tags. These tags should be affixed to your luggage the morning of embarkation. Additional details will be provided as we approach these dates.
